METALGATE RECORDS PROUDLY PRESENTS: F.O.B. – TOMORROW'S FIRES

In January 2011, death-metalcore devastators F.O.B. from Tábor ventured into studio to spawn the successor to the highly acclaimed album “The Dice”, their fourth full-length album entitled “Tomorrow’s Fires”. From band’s own point of view, this creation is in many aspects a turning point. In the two-year interval between aforementioned albums, F.O.B. evolved not only music-wise, but also, with the arrival of new guitarist Jarek, in terms of the overall band’s presentation. Ten tracks of the new album are clearly influenced with modern metalcore scene, yet keeping the characteristic face of F.O.B. You can thus look forward to diverse melodies and vocal parts linked with cutting riffs, deathcore drive and existential lyrics. In short:

Spontaneous, uncompromising, addictive!

The band F.O.B. was established on the Czech metal scene in 1995, initially as a trash-death-doom metal act. Already the second demo, entitled “fobia”, meant a departure from the doom melancholy and inclination to modern approaches to metal music. This trend was further underlined by the debut album “Follow The Instructions” and definitively confirmed by the third album “The Dice – the seventh dot for certain victory”. In course of its existence, F.O.B. gained rich concert experiences, both at club and festival stages, including live shows abroad, such as at Kaltenbach open air or Hells Pleasure fest.

Album “Tomorrow’s Fires” is released by MetalGate Records in digipack format with bonus videoclip for the song “Rain of Thoughts”. The CD was unveiled with full parade during the 13th installment of Žižkův vraždící palcát festival in Tábor, at which the act itself was undertaken by Jan Žižka of Trocnov himself, resurrected exclusively for this occasion.
